We were advised today that one of our staff/students has tested positive for the COVID-19 virus. We have been coordinating with the Sullivan County Department of Health and they have indicated that due to the timing of the onset of symptoms and the last date of the individual being physically present in a district building/vehicle there is no requirement of contact tracing and no additional action is necessary at this time. Should additional actions become necessary, we will immediately notify parents, faculty and staff of any changes in procedures and protocols. As a result, the school operations will continue as normal.

We understand that news like this can be received with mixed emotions from our school community. Rest assured the safety and health of our students and staff are our top priority. Due to privacy requirements, we cannot divulge specific information about any individual who has a confirmed or suspected case of COVID-19.


